1. ***Timing***:

Pitchers/defense is allowed warm track(s). Once the official calls balls to come in then the offense's music takes over with batting order walk out songs.

3. ***Genre & Content***:

Choose music that's suitable for all ages and avoids offensive language or themes. Opt for non-explicit tracks when building a playlist.

3. ***Volume Adjustment***:

Be prepared to adjust the volume if asked by players, coaches, or officials. The ump has the right to cease music privileges of a team.
